## **CLINICAL REVIEW ITEMS**

- Assure that the provider contacted the member's primary care physician and case manager, if applicable, as a part of coordinating care for the member.
- Verification and documentation contained in the medical record supporting
  whether or not the member is currently taking medications of any kind. If the
  member is currently taking medication the provider must have documentation
  supporting that there is a plan for medication management in place.
- Verification and documentation contained in the medical record supporting whether or not the member has been seen by a psychiatrist or psychologist prior to seeking services from the behavioral health provider.
- Verification and documentation contained in the medical record supporting whether or not the provider checked for EPSDT screenings for the member.
- Verification and documentation contained in the medical record supporting whether or not a discharge plan is in place for the member.
- Verification and documentation of the service authorization to include any attestation.
- Verification of plan of care and any supporting documentation.
- Verification of provider qualifications to include licensing and credentialing information.
